The journey to the lodge is part of the experience, winding through rich, green forest before emerging at the escarpment's edge, where exceptional panoramic views across Lake Manyara and the Great Rift Valley unfold. The lodge features 52 spacious canvas tents, thoughtfully designed to deliver an authentic safari atmosphere while ensuring modern comfort. Ideally located for

exploring Lake Manyara National Park, the Ngorongoro Crater, and Tarangire National Park, Africa Safari Manyara Migombani is the perfect base for discovery.

After a day of adventure, guests can relax by the swimming pool, savour a refreshing drink against a backdrop of sweeping views, indulge in a rejuvenating spa treatment.

PARK INFORMATION
What you should know

For entry to Lake Manyara National Park, TANAPA entry fees apply. These apply to both people and vehicles. Agents must pay these fees electronically online, whilst for private visitors Africa Safari Manyara Migombani can assist. Ngorongoro (both Crater and Conservation Area) and Tarangire National Parks have their own park entry/conservation fees, and these too are best applied for and paid in advance online.

Lake Manyara National Park

Located at the base of the Great Rift Valley escarpment, Lake Manyara National Park is a compact yet remarkably diverse safari destination. A bird lover's paradise, more than 400 species have been recorded here. The park is especially famous for the thousands of flamingos that gather along the shores of the alkaline lake, creating a striking pink fringe along the water's edge. An entrance road winds through dense groundwater forest before opening onto lakeshore plains where zebra, wildebeest, giraffe and buffalo can often be seen grazing. The park is also known for its hippos and its unusual tree-climbing lions, sometimes spotted resting in the branches of mahogany and acacia trees.



Tarangire National Park

Tarangire National Park is a fun and easy park to explore. The game is abundant and exposed because the park is more compact, and the terrain is open. In the dry season, the Tarangire River is the only permanent source of water. Tarangire National Park is 2850 square kilometres in size, making it the sixth largest park in Tanzania. It offers the highest concentration of wildlife after the Serengeti. Tarangire is known for its Baobab trees and the large herds of elephants that can be seen from close by. Other animals that can be seen are wildebeests, zebras, buffaloes, gazelles, rhinos, warthogs, impalas, pythons, lions, leopards and almost 500 species of birds.



NGORONGORO CRATER

Nothing quite prepares you for the sheer beauty of the Ngorongoro Crater. Standing at the rim, looking out over the vast expanse below, with clouds drifting along the edge and a cool mountain breeze in the air, it's a moment that really stays with you.

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the crater is the world's largest intact volcanic caldera and is often referred to as the eighth wonder of the world. Its natural enclosure creates a unique ecosystem, supporting an incredible concentration of wildlife. Here, you'll find the Big Five, including the rare African black rhino, as well as zebra, elephant and hyena, among many others.

The Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see highlight on any northern Tanzania safari.

BIKING AT MTO WA MBU VILLAGE

A fantastic way to stay active while experiencing local life up close, this cycling excursion takes you through a vibrant village setting. Pedal past farms, schools, and churches as you soak in everyday rhythms, all set against stunning views of the surrounding valley and lake.



ZIPLINE ADVENTURE

An exhilarating experience at the Zipline Adventure Park, set at the base of the Great Rift Valley. The course features four thrilling zip lines and five eco platforms, taking you soaring through the air in a secure harness. Glide between ancient baobab trees while taking in sweeping views across the Maasai landscape.



MAASAI BOMA TOUR AT MTO WA MBU

The Maasai are known for their striking red garments and intricate beadwork. This semi-nomadic community has a long tradition of pastoralism, with daily life centred around caring for and grazing their cattle, which hold deep cultural significance. During a visit to a traditional homestead, or manyatta, you'll be welcomed by the community, experience the Adumu (their iconic jumping dance), and gain insight into their beadwork and craftsmanship.



GUIDED BIRD WATCHING

Head to the entrance of Lake Manyara National Park, a renowned haven for birdlife and one of East Africa's top birding destinations. Here, you'll encounter an incredible variety of species, from flocks of pink flamingos to pelicans, storks, and herons. With the guidance of experienced experts, you'll have the chance to spot rare and migratory birds while learning more about their behaviours and the rich ecosystem they inhabit.



TREETOP WALKWAY LAKE MANYARA

Why not elevate your safari experience at Lake Manyara National Park with a treetop adventure? Traverse a 370-metre aerial walkway that gently ascends up to 18 metres above the forest floor, offering a unique vantage point to admire the lush canopy, spot wildlife, and immerse yourself in the sounds and sights of nature from a whole new perspective.



TARANGIRE BALLOON SAFARI

Head out before dawn to witness the magic of the balloon coming to life as pilots fill the vibrant canopies with air. Drift gently over the stunning landscapes of Tarangire National Park, keeping an eye out for its iconic "Giants of the African Wilderness"- majestic elephants and towering baobab trees. The entire flight lasts about an hour, offering unforgettable views from above.



Safari Jeep

A four-wheel drive safari jeep with a pop-up roof, including driver and fuel, is available for hire on request. Our driver guides are very knowledgeable and will ensure you have as much time as you need to ask questions, take pictures and enjoy the incredible landscape.

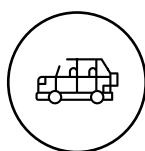

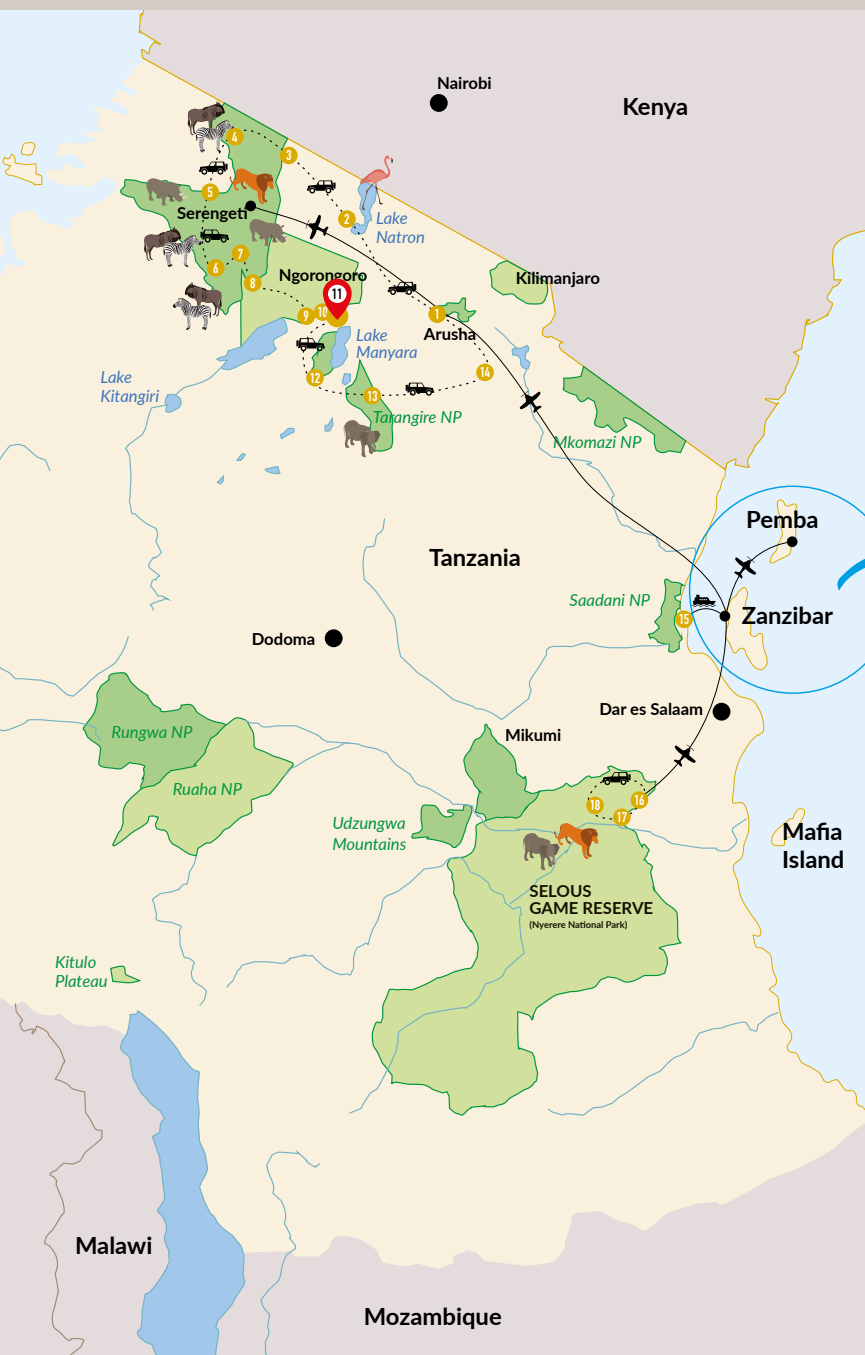
